Through your generous donations to our previous auctions, which took place every two years, we were able to continue to do great things for our community.

This year, we will return to the Steamboat Tennis & Athletic Club. This auction, themed "Steamboat Stampede", will be a night of drinks, heavy hors d'oeuvres, a silent auction of carefully curated items, as well as wonderful live items to be auctioned off. - "The Principal's Checkbook", a fund created for the Administration and Faculty to use for any student in need in our school, especially in emergency situations.
- Senior luncheons for long-time community members and alumni to rekindle and maintain those endearing ties to Griffin School and one another
- Engraved pavers display honoring community members and local families with pavers placed in a prominent location at Griffin School
- Electronic reader board for school and community announcements

This year, our fundraising goal will be to enhance education to students at Griffin by making our event proceeds available to the school district through our twice-yearly grant program, thus giving teachers and staff the ability to request funding for items they really need to keep the classrooms functioning during this time of budget cuts, and funding for our yearly scholarships and Principal's Checkbook fund.
